

RESOLUTION NO. 2019-22

A RESOLUTION OF THE VERNAL CITY COUNCIL REQUESTING THE RECERTIFICATION OF THE JUSTICE COURT FOR VERNAL CITY.

WHEREAS, the provisions of UCA 78A-7-103 require that Justice Courts be recertified at the end of each four-year term; and

WHEREAS, the term of the present Vernal City Justice Court shall expire on the 31st day of December, 2019; and

WHEREAS, the members of the Vernal City Council have received an opinion letter from Dennis Judd, the Vernal City Attorney, which sets forth the requirements for the operation of a Justice Court and feasibility of continuing to maintain the same; and

WHEREAS, the members of the Vernal City Council have determined that it is in the best interests of Vernal City to continue to provide a Justice Court.


THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE VERNAL CITY COUNCIL hereby requests recertification of the Vernal City Justice Court by the Board of Justice Court Judges and the Utah Judicial Council.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED BY THE VERNAL CITY COUNCIL hereby affirms their willingness to continue to meet all requirements set forth by the Judicial Council for continued operation of the Vernal City Justice Court for the next four-year term of the court, except as to any requirement waived by the Utah Judicial Council.

Severability. The provisions of this resolution shall be severable and if any provision thereof or the application of such provision under any circumstances is held invalid, it shall not affect any other provision of this resolution or the application in a different circumstance.


Effective date. This resolution shall become effective immediately upon adoption.
