

RESOLUTION NO. 2018-12

A RESOLUTION OF THE VERNAL CITY COUNCIL AMENDING THE PERSONNEL POLICIES AND PROCEDURES, SECTION 6.04.020 - MEMBERSHIP IN THE UTAH STATE RETIREMENT SYSTEMS.

WHEREAS, Vernal City has determined that the best interests and welfare of the public within their jurisdiction will best be served by approving this Resolution; and

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED by the Vernal City Council as follows:

Section 1. Section 6.04.020 is hereby amended to read as follows

6.04.020 Membership in the Utah State Retirement System.

A. Certain categories of employees of Vernal City are required to become members of the Utah State Retirement System upon hire. These categories include the following:

1. Employees working twenty (20) or more hours per week and receiving benefits from the City classified as permanent full-time and permanent part-time employees;

B. For the purpose of Utah Retirement Systems (URS) the City classifies all elected officials as part-time. Eligibility for retirement coverage under Utah Retirement Systems shall be administered in accordance with the statutory rules governing Utah Retirement Systems.

C. ~~Certain Elected and~~ administrative appointed officials of the City ~~including the Mayor, City Manager, Assistant City Manager and Finance Director~~ may elect to be exempted from participation in the Utah State Retirement System based on meeting qualification requirements for exemption as stipulated by the Utah State Retirement System.


D. Retirement contributions for employees hired by Vernal City prior to July 1, 2011 who are retired from the Utah State Retirement System prior to July 1, 2011, but still employed by Vernal City shall be made to the Utah State Retirement System 401K account at the amount approved by the Vernal City Council and in compliance with Utah State Retirement policies and regulations.

E. There shall be no retirement contributions for employees hired by Vernal City after July 1, 2011 who are retired from the Utah State Retirement System and are returning to work or continuing to work for the City after retirement, in compliance with the Utah State Retirement System policies and regulations. (Amended 11/03/2004, Res.2004-15)

Severability. The provisions of this resolution shall be severable and if any provision thereof or the application of such provision under any circumstances is held invalid, it shall not effect any other provision of this resolution or the application in a different circumstance.


Effective date. This resolution shall become effective immediately upon adoption.
