**VERNAL CITY PUBLIC HEARING
COMMUNITY IMPACT BOARD FUNDING APPLICATION**

DOWNTOWN VERNAL FLOOD MITIGATION AND STORM DRAINAGE PROJECT.

The Vernal City Council is soliciting public input regarding the application of Vernal City to the Permanent Community Impact Fund Board of the State of Utah for the purpose of securing funding for the Downtown Vernal Flood Mitigation and Storm Drainage Project in identified areas of need within the corporate limits of Vernal City.

The application for this project to the Community Impact Board is to request funding for an amount not to exceed \$1,400,000 in both grant and loan funding. Any repayment of loan debt shall be from the general fund or fuel tax of Vernal City.

The public is invited to give their input to the Vernal City Council regarding the submission of this funding application at a public hearing to be held October 3, 2018 at 7:15 p.m. in the Vernal City Council Chambers, 374 East Main, Vernal, Utah.
